



## **Summary of the Uig Community Trust AGM** **26<sup>th</sup> February 2026**

- The Trust and new Local Development Officer (LDO) were introduced to members.
- BH ran through the Trust finances for the financial year April '24 to March '25. Upcoming larger expenses will be the community website, and possibly more defibrillators for the area.

### **Review of 2025**

- **Uig Filling Station**

BH reported that the lease for the Filling Station and café expires in October. Interviews for a new leaseholder will begin w/c 2<sup>nd</sup> March.

- **Redevelopment of the pier area**

Community engagement and feedback on this whole area is now critical and will be prioritised by the Trust and LDO.

- **Redevelopment of Uig Primary School**

The Trust will fund a Housing Needs Assessment and QS work, which is the next step to unlocking any potential funding.

- **Bay Moorings Project**

The Trust has secured 5 moorings and a pontoon that were due for removal by Highland Council.

- **Working with Uig Community Hall**

All groups have improved communication and the Trust is working more closely with the Hall and the Community Council (CC)

- **Uig Kindness Cabin**

The cabin now has 10 volunteers and works closely with other charities and businesses to maximise the different items coming in. 7.5 tonnes of food waste has been saved.

- **Defibs**

The Trust has worked with Lucky2Bhere and funded 2 more defibs at the Village Hall and Glenhinnisdal. There is a full list of locations including maps on the new community website.

- **Pathways and Cycle Project**

The Trust has continued the CC's work on trying to reduce the speed limit in Earlish and to create a safe pathway from Earlish into the village.

- **Community Website**
